Please be advised that the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) 2 resolved to declare the retroactive suspension of the above-stated procurement project **effective March 29, 2021** due to the COVID-19 pandemic, subsequent declaration of the State of Calamity and the implementation of community quarantine throughout the National Capital Region, pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 09 – 2020 entitled "Approving Measures for the Efficient Conduct of Procurement Activities During a State of Calamity, or Implementation of Community Quarantine or Similar Restrictions."

Consequently, the BAC 2 would also like to notify all concerned bidders on the estimated resumption of the procurement activities for the aforesaid project upon lifting of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) or other similar government restrictions.

Also, please take note of the following implications of the suspension:

- All financial bids/offers/proposals shall be fixed all throughout the bidding/procurement process;
- Extension of the Validity of Bids and Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration for another sixty (60) calendar days;
- Eligibility and post-qualification requirements shall be ensured by the bidders to be valid for another sixty (60) calendar days commencing from the date of the original expiration date of the validity of bids and bid security/bid securing declaration; and
- Tolling the Period of the Bidding/Procurement Activity starting from the date of suspension.
