**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RETROACTIVE SUSPENSION OF  
ON-GOING PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES HANDLED BY THE BBAC CF-DAVAO AND  
THE EVENTUAL RESUMPTION THEREOF**

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**WHEREAS**, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared a COVID-19 pandemic;

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2020, the President signed Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines following the confirmed local transmission of the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19);

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2020, due to the rapid increase of cases of infection in the country, the President signed Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines for a period of six (6) months or up to September 12, 2020, unless lifted earlier or extended as circumstances may warrant, and further providing for the implementation of "Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ)" over the entire Luzon until April 12, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, Davao City is placed under a General Community Quarantine by the Inter-Agency Task Force beginning November 19 to 30, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 1021 extending the State of Calamity in the country until September 12, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to control the COVID-19 cases in Davao City because of the full occupancy of the COVID-19 beds in the Southern Philippines Medical Center (SPMC);

**WHEREAS**, Davao City is retained under a General Community Quarantine by the Inter-Agency Task Force until January 31, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, the City Mayor of Davao City issued an order extending Executive Order No. 56 s. 2020 until June 30, 2021 to continuously avoid a close contact scenario for all employees and to decongest passengers of public utility vehicles throughout the day to lessen the risk of transmission;

**WHEREAS**, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) issued GPPB Resolution No. 09 – 2020, entitled "Approving Measures for the Efficient Conduct of the Procurement activities during a state of calamity, or the Implementation of Community Quarantine or Similar Restrictions;" , became effective last May 15, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, under the aforesaid GPPB Resolution No. 09 – 2020, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is allowed to suspend the conduct of procurement activities adversely affected or interrupted by the declaration of a State of Calamity, or implementation of community quarantine or similar restrictions at any time during the existence of such

calamity, or quarantine or similar restrictions, and when it has assessed or determined that:

1. No Bidder will be able to submit a Bid or comply with the requirements of the procurement rules due to the limitations resulting from the declaration of a State of Calamity, or implementation of a community quarantine or similar restrictions; or
2. The conduct of procurement activities cannot be undertaken without endangering the health and welfare of its personnel despite the work from home or other alternative work arrangements.

**WHEREAS**, in case of suspension, the BAC shall notify all prospective bidders and post a notice on the PE's website, if any;

**WHEREAS**, the notice shall include the suspension of the conduct of procurement activities for a specific procurement project/program, its estimated date of resumption and all the implications of such suspension which shall include, but not limited to the fixed price rule in procurement, extension of the bid validity and security, validity of the eligibility requirements prior to the award of contract, conditions of award, and the revised date of delivery;

**WHEREAS**, given the COVID-19 pandemic, Procuring Entities may retroactively suspend the conduct of procurement activities beginning March 9, 2020 following the declaration by the President of a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines, subject to the determination by the BAC of the existence of any of the grounds for the suspension of the conduct of procurement activities and compliance with the notice requirement;

**WHEREAS**, through the BAC declaration of the suspension of various on-going procurement activities, the BAC is consequently allowed to toll the periods for the Procurement Projects covered by the suspension, including the running of the three (3) month period to award the contract and terminate the procurement process under Section 38 of RA No. 9184, during the suspension of the conduct of procurement activities, as determined by the BAC;

**WHEREAS**, the suspension of the conduct of procurement activities shall be lifted upon determination of the BAC that the basis for the suspension no longer exists or upon the lifting of the State of Calamity, or implementation of community quarantine or similar restrictions, as the case may be;

**WHEREAS**, upon determination of the BAC that the basis for the suspension no longer exists and resumption of the procurement activities, the BAC shall notify all affected bidders of the lifting of the suspension and post a notice on the PE's website, if any.

**WHEREAS**, the period for the conduct of procurement activities shall run again upon posting of the notice of resumption of procurement activities on the website of the PE, if any, or in the absence thereof, any conspicuous place in the premises of the PE;

**WHEREAS**, the procuring entity shall likewise inform the affected bidders of the resumption of procurement activities for the participation and/or compliance, as the case may be;

**WHEREAS**, the period of action on procurement activities shall not commence anew but rather, grants the procuring entity the balance of the remaining period available for the conduct of procurement activities which has been tolled or suspended;

**WHEREAS**, the on-going projects being handled by the BBAC CF-Davao are detailed as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the BBAC CF-Davao resolved to declare the retroactive suspension of the above-mentioned on-going procurement activity being handled by the Committee effective January 1, 2021, taking into consideration the following:

1. The GPPB Resolution No. 09 – 2020 just became effective last May 15, 2020;
2. The BBAC is expressly given the authority by the GPPB Resolution No. 09 – 2020 to declare the retroactive suspension of all procurement activities beginning March 9, 2020 following the declaration by the President of a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines;

3. Determination by the BBAC of the existence of sufficient grounds to declare the retroactive suspension of the conduct of procurement activities arising from the COVID-19 pandemic;
4. The BBAC is allowed to suspend the conduct of procurement activities adversely affected or interrupted by the declaration of a State of Calamity, or implementation of community quarantine or similar restrictions at any time during the existence of such calamity, or quarantine or similar restrictions.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, We, the Members of the Branch Bids and Awards Committee (BBAC) CF-Davao hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to declare the retroactive suspension of the proceeding procurement activities effective January 1, 2021, and the eventual resumption thereof based on the following schedules:
