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Glossary of Acronyms, Terms, and Abbreviations

ABC –Approved Budget for the Contract.

BAC – Bids and Awards Committee.

Bid – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as *Proposal* and *Tender*. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[c])

Bidder – Refers to a contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

Bidding Documents – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])

BIR – Bureau of Internal Revenue.

BSP – Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas.

Consulting Services – Refer to services for Infrastructure Projects and other types of projects or activities of the GOP requiring adequate external technical and professional expertise that are beyond the capability and/or capacity of the GOP to undertake such as, but not limited to: (i) advisory and review services; (ii) pre-investment or feasibility studies; (iii) design; (iv) construction supervision; (v) management and related services; and (vi) other technical services or special studies. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[i])

CDA - Cooperative Development Authority.

Contract – Refers to the agreement entered into between the Procuring Entity and the Supplier or Manufacturer or Distributor or Service Provider for procurement of Goods and Services; Contractor for Procurement of Infrastructure Projects; or Consultant or Consulting Firm for Procurement of Consulting Services; as the case may be, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.

CIF – Cost Insurance and Freight.

CIP – Carriage and Insurance Paid.

CPI – Consumer Price Index.

DDP – Refers to the quoted price of the Goods, which means “delivered duty paid.”

DTI – Department of Trade and Industry.

EXW – Ex works.

FCA – “Free Carrier” shipping point.

FOB – “Free on Board” shipping point.

Foreign-funded Procurement or Foreign-Assisted Project–Refers to procurement whose funding source is from a foreign government, foreign or international financing institution as specified in the Treaty or International or Executive Agreement. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[b]).

Framework Agreement – Refers to a written agreement between a procuring entity and a supplier or service provider that identifies the terms and conditions, under which specific purchases, otherwise known as “Call-Offs,” are made for the duration of the agreement. It is in the nature of an option contract between the procuring entity and the bidder(s) granting the procuring entity the option to either place an order for any of the goods or services identified in the Framework Agreement List or not buy at all, within a minimum period of one (1) year to a maximum period of three (3) years. (GPPB Resolution No. 27-2019)

GFI – Government Financial Institution.

GOCC –Government-owned and/or –controlled corporation.

Goods – Refer to all items, supplies, materials and general support services, except Consulting Services and Infrastructure Projects, which may be needed in the transaction of public businesses or in the pursuit of any government undertaking, project or activity, whether in the nature of equipment, furniture, stationery, materials for construction, or personal property of any kind, including non-personal or contractual services such as the repair and maintenance of equipment and furniture, as well as trucking, hauling, janitorial, security, and related or analogous services, as well as procurement of materials and supplies provided by the Procuring Entity for such services. The term “related” or “analogous services” shall include, but is not limited to, lease or purchase of office space, media advertisements, health maintenance services, and other services essential to the operation of the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[r])

GOP – Government of the Philippines.

GPPB – Government Procurement Policy Board.

INCOTERMS – International Commercial Terms.

Infrastructure Projects – Include the construction, improvement, rehabilitation, demolition, repair, restoration or maintenance of roads and bridges, railways,

airports, seaports, communication facilities, civil works components of information technology projects, irrigation, flood control and drainage, water supply, sanitation, sewerage and solid waste management systems, shore protection, energy/power and electrification facilities, national buildings, school buildings, hospital buildings, and other related construction projects of the government. Also referred to as *civil works or works*. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[u])

LGUs – Local Government Units.

NFCC – Net Financial Contracting Capacity.

NGA – National Government Agency.

PhilGEPS - Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System.

Procurement Project – refers to a specific or identified procurement covering goods, infrastructure project or consulting services. A Procurement Project shall be described, detailed, and scheduled in the Project Procurement Management Plan prepared by the agency which shall be consolidated in the procuring entity's Annual Procurement Plan. (GPPB Circular No. 06-2019 dated 17 July 2019)

PSA – Philippine Statistics Authority.

SEC – Securities and Exchange Commission.

SLCC – Single Largest Completed Contract.

Supplier – refers to a citizen, or any corporate body or commercial company duly organized and registered under the laws where it is established, habitually established in business and engaged in the manufacture or sale of the merchandise or performance of the general services covered by his bid. (Item 3.8 of GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019, dated 23 May 2019). Supplier as used in these Bidding Documents may likewise refer to a distributor, manufacturer, contractor, or consultant.

**INVITATION TO BID FOR THE Procurement of Hotel Room
Accommodation for Customers, Guests and Officers of CF-Bacolod
for a Period of Three (3) Years Contract
under ITB NO. PB21-02-001BAC**

1. The Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR), through the PAGCOR's Corporate Budget for CY 2021 intends to apply the annual Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Four Million Pesos (PhP 4,000,000.00)**, VAT Exclusive, Zero-Rated Transaction, or a **total ABC for three (3) years of Twelve Million Pesos (PhP 12,000,000.00)**, VAT Exclusive, Zero-Rated Transaction, being the total ABC to payments under the contract for the **Procurement of Hotel Room Accommodation for Customers, Guests and Officers of CF-Bacolod for a Period Three (3) Years Contract**.

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The PAGCOR now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required for a period of **three (3) years commencing from the date of receipt by the winning contractor of the Notice to Proceed**. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "*pass/fail*" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from PAGCOR and interested bidders may inspect and obtain further information from the Procurement Section (PS), acting as the BAC Secretariat, of PAGCOR and/or inspect the Bidding Documents at the Casino Filipino – Bacolod, Ground Floor, Procurement Office, 15th Corner Aguinaldo Street Bacolod City, during office hours of PAGCOR from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **February 9, 2021, (Tuesday) to March 2, 2021 (Tuesday)** from the given address and website(s) below upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Twenty-Five Thousand Pesos (PhP25,000.00)**.

PAGCOR shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees either in person, by facsimile, or through electronic means.

Prospective bidders may also download the Bidding Documents free of charge from www.pagcor.ph and www.philgeps.gov.ph and may be allowed to submit bids provided that bidders pay the applicable fee of the Bidding Documents not later than the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.

In effecting payment for the Bidding Documents, prospective bidders shall present either the Payment Slip, which may be secured from the PS, or a copy of this Invitation to Bid (ITB) to Finance Section, located at the Casino Filipino – Bacolod, 2nd Floor, 15th Corner Aguinaldo Street, Bacolod City.

The PAGCOR will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on February 18, 2021 (Thursday), 11:00 a.m. at the Casino Filipino – Bacolod, Procurement Office, 15th Corner Aguinaldo Street, Bacolod City**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.

6. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission on or before **March 2, 2021 (Tuesday), 11:00 am** at the **Casino Filipino – Bacolod, Procurement Office, Ground Floor, 15th Corner Aguinaldo Street Bacolod City**. Late bids shall not be accepted.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
8. Bid opening shall be on **March 2, 2021 (Tuesday), 11:00 am** at the **Casino Filipino – Bacolod, Procurement Office, Ground Floor, 15th Corner Aguinaldo Street Bacolod City**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
9. Bidders shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their bids, and PAGCOR will in no case, be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

Bidders should note that PAGCOR will accept bids only from those that have paid the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents.

PAGCOR assumes no responsibility whatsoever to compensate or indemnify bidders for any expenses incurred in the preparation of their bids.

In accordance with Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Circular 06-2005 - Tie-Breaking Method, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) shall use a non-discretionary and non-discriminatory measure based on sheer luck

or chance, which is “DRAW LOTS,” in the event that two (2) or more bidders have been post-qualified and determined as the bidder having the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (LCRB) to determine the final bidder having the LCRB, based on the following procedures:

- a) In alphabetical order, the bidders shall pick one rolled paper.
 - b) The lucky bidder who would pick the paper with a “CONGRATULATIONS” remark shall be declared as the final bidder having the LCRB and recommended for award of the contract.
10. The PAGCOR reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

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Section II. Instructions to Bidders

1. Scope of Bid

The Procuring Entity, Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR), wishes to receive Bids for the Procurement of Hotel Room Accommodation for Customers, Guests and Officers of CF-Bacolod for a Period of Three (3) years Contract under ITB No. PB21-02-001BAC with an annual ABC of **Four Million Pesos (PhP 4,000,000.00)**, VAT Exclusive, Zero-Rated Transaction, OR a **total ABC for three (3) years of Twelve Million Pesos (PhP 12,000,000.00)**, VAT Exclusive, Zero-Rated Transaction.

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is composed of one (1) lot, the details of which are described in Section VII (Technical Specifications):

2. Funding Information

2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for CY 2021 in the annual ABC of **Four Million Pesos (PhP 4,000,000.00)**, VAT Exclusive, Zero-Rated Transaction, OR a **total ABC for three (3) years of Twelve Million Pesos (PhP 12,000,000.00)**, VAT Exclusive, Zero-Rated Transaction.

2.2. The source of funding is the Corporate Operating Budget – PAGCOR's Corporate Budget for CY 2021.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or **IB** by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Suppliers, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

- 5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.
- 5.2. Foreign ownership limited to those allowed under the rules may participate in this Project.
- 5.3. Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.
- 5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.1 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin of Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN, subject to Domestic Preference requirements under **ITB** Clause 18.

7. Subcontracts

- 7.1. The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than twenty percent (20%) of the Project.

The Procuring Entity has prescribed that Subcontracting is not allowed.

8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a Pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time at its physical address, Casino Filipino – Bacolod, Ground Floor, Procurement Office, 15th Corner Aguinaldo Street Bacolod as indicated in paragraph 6 of the **IB**.

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the **IB**, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in **Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)**.

- 10.2. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in **ITB** Clause 5.3 should have been completed within three (3) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.
- 10.3. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

11. Documents comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- 11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in **Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)**.
- 11.2. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity, a certification issued by DTI shall be provided by the Bidder in accordance with Section 43.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 11.3. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the **IB** shall not be accepted.
- 11.4. For Foreign-funded Procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Bid Prices

- 12.1. Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be entered separately in the following manner:
 - a. For Goods offered from within the Procuring Entity's country:
 - i. The price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, ex-warehouse, ex-showroom, or off-the-shelf, as applicable);
 - ii. The cost of all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable;

- iii. The cost of transportation, insurance, and other costs incidental to delivery of the Goods to their final destination; and
 - iv. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, listed in e.
- b. For Goods offered from abroad:
- i. Unless otherwise stated in the **BDS**, the price of the Goods shall be quoted delivered duty paid (DDP) with the place of destination in the Philippines as specified in the **BDS**. In quoting the price, the Bidder shall be free to use transportation through carriers registered in any eligible country. Similarly, the Bidder may obtain insurance services from any eligible source country.
 - ii. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, as listed in **Section VII (Technical Specifications)**.

13. Bid and Payment Currencies

- 13.1. For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.
- 13.2. Payment of the contract price shall be made in Philippine Pesos.

14. Bid Security

- 14.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the **BDS**, which shall be not less than the percentage of the annual ABC in accordance with the schedule in the **BDS**.
- 14.2. The Bid and bid security shall be valid for one hundred twenty (120) calendar days from the date of the Submission, Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids. Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

15. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

16. Deadline for Submission of Bids

16.1. The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the **IB**.

17. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

17.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the **IB**. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat.

In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

17.2. The preliminary examination of bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

18. Domestic Preference

18.1. The Procuring Entity will grant a margin of preference for the purpose of comparison of Bids in accordance with Section 43.1.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

19.1. The Procuring BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "*passed*," using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case maybe. In this case, the Bid Security as required by **ITB** Clause 15 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.

- 19.3. The descriptions of the lots or items shall be indicated in **Section VII (Technical Specifications)**, although the ABCs of these lots or items are indicated in the **BDS** for purposes of the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184. The NFCC must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.
- 19.4. The Project shall be awarded as One Project having several items grouped into several lots, which shall be awarded as separate contracts per lot.
- 19.5. Except for bidders submitting a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation, all Bids must include the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.1.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, which must be sufficient for the total of the annual ABC. For bidders submitting the committed Line of Credit, it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the annual ABC.

20. Post-Qualification

- 20.2. Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS) and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the **BDS**.

21. Signing of the Contract

- 21.1. The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the **BDS**.

Each referred to as a "**PARTY**" and collectively as the "**PARTIES**".

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, PAGCOR has a requirement for the Procurement of Hotel Room Accommodation for Customers, Guests and Officers of CF-Bacolod for a Period of Three (3) Years Contract under ITB No. PB21-02-001BAC (hereinafter referred to as the "Services");

WHEREAS, PAGCOR conducted a public bidding in accordance with Republic Act 9184 (Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations on _____ for the procurement of the Services;

8. The CONTRACTOR shall extend special discounted rates on Recreational facilities, Function room, Banquet facilities and a twenty percent (20%) discount on other amenities offered by the establishment, as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The establishment of the CONTRACTOR is within 500 meters from Casino Filipino - Bacolod.
2. The CONTRACTOR has the ambiance of at least 3 star hotel / business hotel.

 6. Official check-out time is at 12:00 noon on the day of departure. Check-out after 3:00 pm and before 6:00 pm shall be charged half day rate while check-out after 6:00pm shall be charged full rate.
 7. In the event of guest's extension of stay, PAGCOR, CF-Bacolod will forward to CONTRACTOR Front Office a Letter of Authority (LOA) for extended stay or Notice of Revision a day prior to extension date and which will be subject to space availability. Failure to send the LOA on the prescribed date will result for the extension to be charged at the Hotel's prevailing published rates and charged to the guest's personal account. The usual credit card requirements will be secured from the guest prior to the extension of stay.
 8. PAGCOR special rate and discount privilege maybe extended to PAGCOR, CF-Bacolod Managers and staff only upon presentation of a valid identification prior to check-in subject to space availability. Settlement shall be on a personal account upon check-in or during the availing of discount privilege.

CONCESSION

1. PAGCOR, CF-Bacolod shall give the following privilege to CONTRACTOR and its all guests, to wit;
 - Free entrance to all Hotel guests
 - Double Your Money Coupon to all hotel guests.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. In the event that the CONTRACTOR fails to comply with any of its undertakings, as set forth in this Service Contract, PAGCOR shall be released from its obligations under this Service Contract, without prejudice to its rights of restitution, recovery and damages.
2. This Service Contract, and all the rights and interests herein, may not be assigned or sub-contracted to another without the consent of the other party.
3. In the event that facts and circumstances arise or are discovered which render this Contract disadvantageous to the Government, as determined by PAGCOR, the Parties hereto agree to immediately to re-negotiate its terms and conditions, or at the option of PAGCOR, terminate the same.
4. This Service Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter contained in it and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous contracts, representations, warranties and understandings of the parties. II. CONTRACT TERM

1. This Contract shall be for a period of three (3) years, which shall be effective from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed. However, this Contract shall be automatically terminated if the Budget is exhausted before the termination date.
2. PAGCOR may terminate this Contract with or without cause, without need for judicial intervention, and without incurring any obligation whatsoever, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the CONTRACTOR.
3. Should the CONTRACTOR incur delay in the performance of its obligations, CONTRACTOR shall pay a penalty of one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) of the total cost of the undelivered Services for each day of delay, including Sundays and Holidays, beyond the specific period. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of the Contract. The CONTRACTOR shall have the entire charge, control and supervision of the Services herein agreed upon. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of its agents, personnel and all persons allowed by it to have access to PAGCOR's

premises, for any injury which may be caused to any person or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part of PAGCOR's premises. Any accident, injury or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any agent, personnel of the CONTRACTOR consequent to the performance of the Services under this Service Contract shall be the CONTRACTOR's sole responsibility. The CONTRACTOR further bids itself to indemnify and hold PAGOCR free and harmless from any claim on account of the aforementioned injuries or damages.

2. All taxes, amounts, claims and expenses pertaining to clearances, licenses, permits, registrations or renewal thereof, required by PAGCOR or the appropriate government entities for the Services to be performed under this Service Contract shall be for the exclusive account of CONTRACTOR.
3. The CONTRACTOR shall pay its taxes in full and on time. The CONTRACTOR shall also present a tax clearance from the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and a copy of its income and business tax returns, duly stamped, received and validated by the BIR, indicating the tax payments made thereon. Its failure to do so shall entitle PAGCOR to suspend payment for services rendered by the CONTRACTOR.

V. INDEMNIFICATION

1. The CONTRACTOR will defend, protect, indemnify, and hold PAGCOR harmless from any and all adverse claims that may be made by any party in connection with this Service Contract. The indemnification is limited to the services delivered to PAGCOR by the CONTRACTOR and does not cover third party claims not authorized by the CONTRACTOR.
2. The CONTRACTOR hereby holds PAGCOR its guests, corporate affiliates, directors, officers, employees and agents free and harmless from any and all actions or liabilities arising out of this Service Contract, including, without being limited to, claims for unpaid and back wages, regularization, and other terms and conditions of employment, as well as civil and criminal liabilities that the CONTRACTOR and/or PAGCOR may incur as a result of, or arising out of, the conduct and/or pursuit of Services and to indemnify the PAGCOR from and against the costs of defending any action, suit or proceedings, including legal fees or other expenses incurred in relation to any such claims mentioned above.
3. The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and shall hold PAGCOR, its directors, officers, employees, agents, customers and guests and corporate affiliates and any employee or agent thereof (each of the foregoing, being hereinafter referred to individually as the "Indemnified Party") free and harmless against any and all liability to third parties (other than liability solely the fault of the indemnified party) arising from the negligence of the CONTRACTOR or its agents including (but not limited to) the violation of any third party's trade secret, proprietary information, trademark, copyright or patent rights in connection with the use of PAGCOR of the CONTRACTOR's services.
