**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESUMPTION OF THE  
BIDDING/PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF PRIVATE  
SECURITY AGENCY FOR CF-BACOLOD AND CF-ILOILO FOR A PERIOD OF  
THREE (3) YEARS**

**WHEREAS**, due to rapid increase of cases of COVID-19 infection in the country and the emerging Delta variant cases, His Excellency President Rodrigo Roa Duterte approved the recommendation of Inter Agency Task Force (IATF), to retain the classification of Metro Manila or the National Capital Region (NCR) under Alert Level 2 effective December 1, 2021 to December 15, 2021 and placing the Bacolod City and the whole of Negros Occidental under Alert Level 2 with heightened restrictions. Starting November 5, 2021. This classification was further extended until December 15, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, in a meeting held last December 8, 2021, the Procurement Section (PS) acting as the BAC Secretariat, informed the BBAC that the verification of eligibility and post qualification documents of the bidder having the Single Calculated Bid (SCB) were still ongoing.

**WHEREAS** the BBAC also considered that the said verification reports cannot be obtained due to the government restrictions being implemented.

**WHEREAS**, in the same meeting the BBAC resolved to declare the retroactive suspension of the procurement activity for the project with the details above effective December 1, 2021 to December 15, 2021 or until the implementation of other similar government restrictions is lifted, taking into consideration the following:

1. The conduct of procurement activities cannot be completed without disregarding the health and welfare of its personnel despite the work from home or other alternative work arrangements;
2. The BBAC is expressly given the authority by the GPPB Resolution 09-2020 to declare the retroactive suspension of all procurement activities beginning March 9, 2020 following the declaration by the President of a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines; and
3. Determination by the BBAC of the existence of sufficient grounds to declare the retroactive suspension of the conduct of procurement activities arising from the COVID-19 pandemic.

**WHEREAS**, under the aforesaid GPPB Resolution No. 09-2020, when the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) resolved to declare the suspension of various on-going bidding/procurement activities, the BAC is consequently allowed to toll the periods for the Procurement Projects covered by the suspension, including the running of the three (3) month period to award the contract and terminate the procurement process under Section 38 of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), during the suspension of the conduct of procurement activities;

**WHEREAS**, the suspension of the conduct of procurement activities shall be lifted upon determination of the BAC that the basis for the suspension no longer exists or upon the lifting of the State of Calamity, or implementation of community quarantine or similar restrictions, as the case may be;

**WHEREAS**, upon determination of the BAC that the basis for the suspension no longer exists and resumption of the procurement activities was declared, the BAC shall notify all affected bidders of the lifting of the suspension and post a notice on the PE's website, if any;

**WHEREAS**, the period for the conduct of procurement activities shall run again upon posting of the notice of resumption of procurement activities on the website of the PE, if any, or in the absence thereof, any conspicuous space in the premises of the PE;

**WHEREAS**, the PE shall likewise inform the affected bidders of the resumption of procurement activities for the participation and/or compliance, as the case may be;

**WHEREAS**, the period of action on procurement activities shall not commence anew but rather, grants the PE the balance of the remaining period available for the conduct of procurement activities which has been tolled or suspended;

**WHEREAS**, in a meeting held on January 7, 2022, the Procurement Section (PS) informed the BBAC that the verification of eligibility and post-qualification documents of the bidder were already completed;

**WHEREAS**, the BBAC, upon determining that the grounds for the suspension no longer exists, resolved to declare the resumption of the bidding/procurement activities of the above-stated procurement project effective **January 10, 2022**;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, We, the Members of the Branch Bids and Awards Committee (BBAC), hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, the following:

1. Declare the resumption of the proceeding bidding/procurement activities effective January 10, 2022; and
2. Issue a Notice of Resumption informing all prospective bidders of the resumption of the proceeding bidding/procurement activities.
