PROCUREMENT (TWO-FAILED BIDDINGS) AND
RE-CONDUCT THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the Branch Bids and Awards Committee (BBAC) CF-Davao has been tasked to handle the procurement of requirements of the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) with the project details presented above;

WHEREAS, the following public biddings were declared a "Failure of Bidding" by the Branch Bids and Awards Committee (BBAC), CF-Davao due to the following reasons:

CB22-01-002DAV (First [1 st] Bidding)	No bids received. The BBAC declared a failure of bidding on 12/28/22, pursuant to Section 35.1.a of the IRR of R.A. 9184, which states: <i>"35.1. The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when: a) No bids are received"</i>
CB22-01-002DAVa-03 (Re-bidding)	No bids received. The BBAC declared a failure of bidding on 02/07/22, pursuant to Section 35.1.a of the IRR of R.A. 9184, which states: <i>"35.1. The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when: a) No bids are received"</i>

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2022, the Branch Manager approved the failure of bidding and conduct of Negotiated Procurement (Two-Failed Bidding) for the Supply and Delivery of Food and Beverages (F&B) for Various Marketing Events under ITB No. FB22-04-002DAV;

WHEREAS, the Request for Quotation (RFQ) for the aforesaid requirement was posted at the websites of the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) and the Philippine Government and Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and in a conspicuous place within the premises of Casino Filipino-Davao from April 5, 2022 to April 29, 2022;

WHEREAS, copies of the RFQ were also sent through email and fax to five (5) prospective bidders;

WHEREAS, on the deadline for the Submission of Best Offer on April 29, 2022, no bidder submitted their quotations, hence, the BBAC of CF-Davao declared a Failure of Negotiated Procurement (Two Failed Bidding), pursuant to Section 35.1 (a) of the IRR of R.A. 9184, which provides that:

Section 35. Failure of Bidding”


35.1. The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when:

1. To declare a Failure of Negotiated Procurement (Two Failed Bidding) for the Supply and Delivery of Food and Beverages (F&B) for Various Marketing Events under ITB No. FB22-04-002DAV, pursuant to Section 35.1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184; and
2. To recommend for the re-Conduct of Negotiated Procurement (Two-Failed Biddings) pursuant to Section 35.5 of the IRR of R.A. 9184 which states that: “Should there occur a second failure of bidding, the procuring entity may resort to negotiated procurement, as provided for in Section 53.1 [Negotiated Procurement (Two Failed Biddings)] of the IRR


