SUBJECT: NOTICE OF AWARD

This refers to the Hiring of the Services of a Trainer who will conduct a Two (2) Day Training on the Salient Provisions of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) under ITB No. 09-26-2012 procured through Negotiated Procurement (Highly Technical) in accordance with Section 53.7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184.

On October 17, 2012, after a thorough evaluation of your offer, the President and Chief Operating Officer, upon the delegated authority of the Board of Directors, accepted your proposal in the total amount of Two Hundred Ninety One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 291,500.00) for two (2) months or Twenty Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 26,500.00) per training for eleven (11) batches less mandated withholding tax. The award of the contract was also approved subject to the terms and conditions provided in the Consultancy Contract.

To guarantee the faithful performance of all your obligations under the Consultancy Contract, the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) shall deduct from your monthly consultancy fee the amount of One Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Five Pesos (Php 1,325.00) as Performance Security, which shall not exceed the total amount of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Five Pesos (Php 14,575.00). The Performance Security shall remain valid until the issuance of the final Certificate of Acceptance.
