

SERVICE CONTRACT

This SERVICE CONTRACT is entered into and executed by and between:

PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION, a government-owned and -controlled corporation created and existing by virtue of *Presidential Decree 1869*, as amended, with office address at PAGCOR Corporate Office, New World Manila Bay Hotel, 1588 M.H. del Pilar Street corner Pedro Gil Street, Malate, Manila, represented in this act by its Officer-In-Charge, **ENRILE DJ. ESGUERRA**, hereinafter referred to as "**PAGCOR**";


-and-


AMARONN FOOD AND SERVICES INCORPORATED, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at the 537 United Nations Avenue Ermita, Manila, represented herein by its Vice-President, **MA. LOURDES S. RODRIGUEZ**, duly authorized for this purpose by a Secretary's Certificate, dated May 14, 2019 attached as **Annex "A"**, hereinafter referred to as the "**CONTRACTOR**".


The parties warrant that they are duly organized, registered, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, and that the parties and their representatives are capable and have the requisite power, authority, permits, clearances and licenses, to enter into this Service Contract and to perform the Services and all of their obligations under this Service Contract.

Collectively referred to as the "Parties"

RECITALS:

 WHEREAS, PAGCOR requires Supply and Delivery of Food and Beverage (Chinese and other Asian cuisines) for Casino Guests under ITB No. FB19-04-001MAB (the "Services");

 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 53.1 (Negotiated Procurement-Two Failed Biddings) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, the CONTRACTOR has submitted a responsive proposal to undertake the said Services and PAGCOR has accepted the proposal of the CONTRACTOR, subject to the terms and conditions hereunder stipulated;

 NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements hereunder specified by these presents, PAGCOR and the CONTRACTOR hereby enter into this Service Contract under the following terms, conditions and stipulations:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The CONTRACTOR undertakes to provide the Services, specifically, the provision of meals and/or snacks and the incidental services for sanitation and cleaning, including all the necessary labor, materials, supplies and equipment, to PAGCOR in Casino Filipino Manila Bay, in accordance with the menu herein attached as "Annex B" and the following technical specifications:

1. The establishment of the Service Provider/ Supplier should be located within Ermita Manila.
2. The Service Provider/Supplier should have proven track record in the restaurant industry or similar services for at least one (1) year.
3. The restaurant of the Service Provider/Supplier should be able to serve various Chinese and other Asian Cuisines to cater food preferences of the casino customers including options for healthy meals and beverages.
4. A request for special menu should be accommodated and readily available when needed.
5. The Service Provider /Supplier should preferably be open during lunch and dinner if not 24 hours to serve the needs of the casino customers and guests anytime within the said casino operation hours.
6. The proximity of the Service Provider/Supplier should be at least 7-10 minutes drive from the casino to meet our requirement of fast and good quality service.
7. The kitchen should be well equipped and sufficiently manned in order to serve bulk orders when needed.
8. The personnel of the Service Provider/Supplier should at all times be well-mannered, courteous, polite, efficient and should display professional skills in dealing with casino customers and guests.
9. The Service Provider /Supplier shall exercise due diligence in providing goods and services and should comply with all food orders of the casino customers and guests.
10. The Service Provider/Supplier should have a certified chef or at least a cook with Certification of National Cookery from TESDA for the best quality of cooking and food handing.
11. The Service Provider/Supplier shall provide twenty percent (20%) discount of the regular price of goods and services to PAGCOR, its authorized representatives and to all PAGCOR employees presenting their PAGCOR IDs. It should also be applied to all PAGCOR guests endorsed on personal account.
12. The range of pricing of goods will be subject for PAGCOR management's evaluation and approval.
13. The Service Provider/Supplier shall extend existing restaurant promo rates and event discounts whenever applicable to casino customers and guests.

14. The Service Provider/Supplier shall provide PAGCOR a menu with corresponding updated price lists of all the Food and Beverages. In the event that the Service Provider/Supplier decides to either modify or have a new set of menu within the period of contract, no changes on menu price shall take effect.

SPECIAL FOOD REQUIREMENTS (MENU CYCLE):

1. The meals and beverages contained in the menu which are being offered by the Service Provider/Supplier to the customers and guests should be mutually agreed upon by PAGCOR and the Service Provider/ Supplier.
2. All goods and services to be offered must be of highest quality and in accordance with PAGCOR's standards taking into consideration further preferences of the casino customers and guests.
3. The menu should consist of various selections from vegetables, fruits, pork, beef, chicken, fish and seafood.
4. The menu should also include various authentic Chinese desserts like buchi, almond, lychees, etc.
5. The menu should include various hot and cold beverages whether in glass, bottle or in cans, such as sodas, juices, wines and mineral water.
6. The menu should offer meals prepared in different flavors and methods of cooking, e.g. broiled, steamed, baked, grilled, fried and sautéed.
7. A quantified financial plan based on the contract price should be applied during the contract period. A proposed guide on monthly menu cycle and expense appropriation for events is attached in ANNEX A and B respectively.

ACTUAL FOOD DELIVERY:

1. Hot food should be served hot at 140F; cold food should be served cold at least 40F.
2. Prevention from food contamination and food poisoning should be well considered.
3. Food arrangement and serving should be attractive to look palatable.
4. Texture and consistency of food should be observed accordingly.
5. Mode of food orders may either be for dine in, delivery/pick up or catering depending on the preference of PAGCOR and its guests.

MODE OF PAYMENT:

1. A Letter of Authority (LOA) shall be provided to the service provider/supplier upon reservation of food and beverage for casino customers and guests.

2. PAGCOR on the other hand shall be billed by the service provider/supplier on a regular basis based on the food and beverage consumption of the casino customers and guests.
3. Payment shall be based on the actual billing and consumption for a period of one year or until the exhaustion of the total contract price whichever comes first.
4. The unit cost shall be based on what is reflected in the Contract as mutually agreed upon by both parties. Service Provider/Supplier should attach the latest price list as part of the submittal.

II. F&B BUDGET and SCHEDULE OF PAYMENT

1. The total budget for this Service Contract shall be **Six Million Nine Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Forty Pesos (PhP 6,952,640.00), VAT Exclusive Zero-Rated Transaction**, (the "Budget").

2. Payment shall be based on actual consumption and billing and shall be subject to the appropriate withholding taxes.

3. PAGCOR shall not be under any obligation to pay the CONTRACTOR the entire amount of the Budget. Moreover, the aggregate billings under this Contract shall not exceed the total budget.

4. The CONTRACTOR shall submit a VAT exclusive and zero rated billing statement to PAGCOR every month together with the corresponding coupons/ invoices duly signed by a qualified guest of PAGCOR and countersigned by a duly authorized PAGCOR representative. However, F&B items / billings found unsatisfactory and / or not conformed to by PAGCOR shall not be paid. PAGCOR shall pay the billing statement within thirty (30) calendar days from its receipt of the billing statement provided that any additional, necessary and / or required supporting documents are submitted by CONTRACTOR and are verified by PAGCOR.

5. PAGCOR shall not be liable for any other costs except as provided for under this Contract.

III. CONTRACT TERM

1. This Contract shall be for a period of one (1) year effective from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed. However, this Contract shall be automatically terminated if the Budget is exhausted before the termination date.

2. PAGCOR may terminate this Contract with or without cause, without need for judicial intervention, and without incurring any obligation whatsoever, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the CONTRACTOR.

3. Should CONTRACTOR incur delay in the performance of its obligations, CONTRACTOR shall pay a penalty of one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) of the total cost of the Contract for each day of delay, including

Sundays and Holidays, beyond the specific period. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of the Contract. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the Agreement, PAGCOR shall have the option to rescind the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

4. In case the CONTRACTOR still fails to deliver the Services after the lapse of thirty (30) days from the supposed date of implementation as provided for in this Contract, PAGCOR shall have the option to terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

IV. NO EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE OR AGENCY/PARTNERSHIP RELATIONSHIP

1. There shall be no employer-employee relationship between PAGCOR and the employees of the CONTRACTOR. The CONTRACTOR shall have the entire charge, control and supervision of the Services herein agreed upon. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of its agents, personnel and all persons allowed by it to have access to PAGCOR's premises, for any injury which may be caused to any person or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part of PAGCOR's premises. Any accident, injury or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any agent, personnel of the CONTRACTOR consequent to the performance of the Services under this Service Contract shall be the CONTRACTOR's sole responsibility. The CONTRACTOR further binds itself to indemnify and hold PAGCOR free and harmless from any claim on account of the aforementioned injuries or damages.

2. Any offense committed by any of the CONTRACTOR's personnel shall constitute a breach of this Service Contract. PAGCOR shall communicate to the CONTRACTOR all instances of such breach for immediate and appropriate action by the CONTRACTOR.

3. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all of obligations as an employer under the *Labor Code*, its implementing rules and regulations and all other applicable laws and regulations. Non-compliance therewith shall be for its exclusive risk and responsibility and shall constitute a violation of and a ground for the termination of this Service Contract.

4. The relationship between the parties shall be limited to the performance of the Services as stipulated under this Service Contract. Nothing herein shall be construed to create a general partnership between the parties, or to authorize any party to bind the other, except as set forth in this Service Contract, or to borrow money on behalf of another party, or to use the credit of any party for any purpose.

V. WARRANTIES, CLEARANCES, PERMITS, LICENSES and TAXES

1. The CONTRACTOR warrants that there are no actions, suits or proceedings pending or threatened, which may have a material adverse effect on its ability to fulfil its obligations under this Contract or on its operations, business, properties, assets or business condition.

2. All taxes, amounts, claims, and expenses pertaining to clearances, licenses, permits, registrations or renewals thereof, required by PAGCOR or the appropriate government entities for the Services to be performed under this Service Contract shall be for the exclusive account of CONTRACTOR.

3. The CONTRACTOR shall pay its taxes in full and on time. The CONTRACTOR shall also present a tax clearance from the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and a copy of its income and business tax returns, duly stamped, received and validated by the BIR, indicating the tax payments made thereon. Its failure to do so shall entitle PAGCOR to suspend payment for services rendered by the CONTRACTOR.

VI. INDEMNIFICATION

1. The CONTRACTOR will defend, protect, indemnify, and hold PAGCOR harmless from any and all adverse claims that may be made by any party in connection with this Service Contract. The indemnification is limited to the services delivered to PAGCOR by the CONTRACTOR and does not cover third party claims not authorized by the CONTRACTOR.

2. The CONTRACTOR hereby holds PAGCOR its guests, corporate affiliates, directors, officers, employees and agents free and harmless from any and all actions or liabilities arising out of this Service Contract, including, without being limited to, claims for unpaid and back wages, regularization, and other terms and conditions of employment, as well as civil and criminal liabilities that the CONTRACTOR and / or PAGCOR may incur as a result of, or arising out of, the conduct and / or pursuit of Services and to indemnify the PAGCOR from and against the costs of defending any action, suit or proceedings, including legal fees or other expenses incurred in relation to any such claims mentioned above.

3. The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and shall hold PAGCOR, its directors, officers, employees, agents, customers and guests and corporate affiliates and any employee or agent thereof (each of the foregoing, being hereinafter referred to individually as the "Indemnified Party") free and harmless against any and all liability to third parties (other than liability solely the fault of the indemnified party) arising from the negligence of the CONTRACTOR or its agents including (but not limited to) the violation of any third party's trade secret, proprietary information, trademark, copyright or patent rights in connection with the use of PAGCOR of the CONTRACTOR's services.

4. The CONTRACTOR agrees to protect and to exercise due care and proper handling of the properties of PAGCOR during the performance of the Services. The CONTRACTOR shall be jointly and severally liable with its personnel and shall indemnify and hold PAGCOR free and harmless for any death, injury or damage to PAGCOR and to third person or loss, breakage, or destruction of properties, as a consequence of the CONTRACTOR's acts or omissions, wilful intent or negligence, during the performance of the Services or its obligations under this Service Contract.

5. The CONTRACTOR shall be liable in case of theft, robbery or any loss to PAGCOR's premises serviced by the CONTRACTOR's personnel. The CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to replace, repair or restitute any loss involving its personnel.

VII. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

To guarantee the faithful performance of the SUPPLIER under this Contract, it shall post a Performance Security prior to the execution of the Contract, in accordance with any of the following schedule:

(c) Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security specific to the contract awarded.	Thirty Percent (30%) Two Million Eighty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Two Pesos (PhP 2,085,792.00)

The Performance Security shall remain valid during the entire contract duration and shall be released only after the issuance of the Certificate of Final Acceptance (issuance of the IAR); Provided that PAGCOR has no claims filed against the contract awardee or the surety or insurance company and it has no claims for labor and materials filed against the contractor.

VIII. WARRANTY SECURITY

A Warranty Security shall be required from the **CONTRACTOR** for a period of one (1) year. The obligation thereof shall be covered by retention money in the amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of monthly payments. The total deductions, however, shall not exceed the total amount of Sixty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Six Pesos and 40/100 (PhP 69,526.40).

The Warranty Security shall be retained by **PAGCOR**, without interest, during the effectivity of this Service Contract. The same shall only be released after the termination of this Service Contract, provided all conditions under this Service Contract have been fully met.

IX. CLAIMS AND DISPUTES

All claims and disputes relating to or arising out of this Contract, shall as much as possible, be settled amicably by the parties before resorting to any judicial action.

If the parties fail to settle their difference or disputes, the parties waiving for the purpose any other venue, hereby agree that the courts of the City of Manila shall be the exclusive venue of any or all actions or suits between the parties to the exclusion of all other courts and venues. This exclusive venue provision shall apply even in cases for declaration of nullity of this Contract in its entirety or in part.


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
