

SERVICE CONTRACT

This SERVICE CONTRACT is entered into and executed by and between:

PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR), a government-owned and -controlled corporation created and existing by virtue of *Presidential Decree 1869*, as amended, with office address at the PAGCOR Executive Office, Hyatt Hotel and Casino Manila, MH Del Pilar cor. Pedro Gil Sts., Malate, Manila, represented in this act by its Chairman and Chief Executive Officer **CRISTINO L. NAGUIAT, JR.** hereinafter referred to as "PAGCOR";

-and-

TREESIDE FOODS, INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at 561 Ronquillo St. cor. Rizal Ave., Sta. Cruz, Manila, represented in this act by its Accounting Supervisor, Jenepher S. Tiamzon, hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR".

The parties warrant that they are duly organized, registered, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, and that the parties and their representatives are capable and have the requisite power, authority, permits, clearances and licenses, to enter into this Service Contract and to perform the Services and all of their obligations under this Service Contract.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, PAGCOR requires food and beverage services for the Casino Guests and Employees of Satellite Operations Group (SOG) 1's Ronquillo and Universal for a period of two (2) years under ITB No.: 05-01-2014 (the "Services");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 50 (c) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184, the CONTRACTOR has submitted a responsive proposal to undertake the said Services and PAGCOR has accepted the proposal of the CONTRACTOR, subject to the terms and conditions hereunder stipulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements hereunder specified by these presents, PAGCOR and the CONTRACTOR hereby enter into this Service Contract under the following terms, conditions and stipulations:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The CONTRACTOR undertakes to provide the Services, specifically, the provision of meals and/or snacks and the incidental services for sanitation and cleaning, including all necessary labor, materials, supplies and equipment, to PAGCOR in its Ronquillo and Universal Satellite, in accordance with the menu as attached herein as Annex A and the technical specifications:

FOR CASINO GUESTS, PLAYERS AND CUSTOMERS FOR RONQUILLO SATELLITE (LOT 1) AND EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

- i. The menu price shall be VAT-Exclusive and zero-rated and shall already include all applicable fees and charges.
- ii. The CONTRACTOR shall extend to PAGCOR a twenty percent (20%) discount for its Services.
- iii. The CONTRACTOR shall not amend the menu without the prior written consent of PAGCOR. The prices herein agreed shall not be subject to any increase or upward adjustment for any reason or cause whatsoever for the duration of the Contract.
- iv. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the cleanliness and sanitation of the f&b area.
- v. The CONTRACTOR shall have at least six (6) personnel per shift which includes the cook, assistant cook, buzz boy, cashier and two (2) food servers to provide the Services and shall own, legally possess and/or have access to all the necessary kitchen and canteen supplies, utensils, equipment necessary for the delivery of the Service, such as, but not limited to:
 - a. Spoons, forks, knives and chopping boards;
 - b. Plates, glasses, cups and saucers;
 - c. Various cookwares;
 - d. Various tablecloths and napkins;
 - e. Stoves, ovens, microwave ovens, grills; and
 - f. Spices and clean containers for the different food ingredients.
- vi. The CONTRACTOR has good title to the items / goods / services being offered and full authority to sell and transfer the same and that the items / goods / services are sold free and clear of all liens, encumbrances, liabilities and adverse claims of every nature and description.
- vii. The CONTRACTOR's utensils shall be sterilized, kept clean and dried properly.
- viii. The CONTRACTOR shall provide the Services twenty four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week or in accordance with the operations of Satellite Operations Group (SOG) 1's Ronquillo and Universal Satellite.

- ix. The goods and services provided by the CONTRACTOR shall comply with PAGCOR's standards and shall always take into consideration the special preferences of PAGCOR, its customers / clientele and / or guests.
- x. The CONTRACTOR shall ensure that its personnel are always well-mannered, courteous, polite, efficient and shall conduct themselves, at all times, in a professional manner towards PAGCOR, its directors, officers, agents, customers and guests.
- xi. The CONTRACTOR's personnel shall secure from the responsible government agency a health / sanitary permit / clearance and submit the same to PAGCOR. The CONTRACTOR shall not field any of its personnel without the requisite government health / sanitary permit / clearance.
- xii. The CONTRACTOR shall ensure that its personnel exercise good personal hygiene, particularly, but not limited to:
- a. Regular and proper hand washing;
 - b. Clean and well trimmed fingernails without nail polish;
 - c. Hair should be neat and tidy. All personnel shall wear a headdress / hair net; and
 - d. Personnel with wounds / sores shall not be allowed to work.
- xiii. The CONTRACTOR's personnel shall, at all times, wear their prescribed uniform including, but not limited to, aprons, headdress / haircaps / hairnet and gloves, which shall be provided by the CONTRACTOR.
- xiv. PAGCOR may require the replacement of any of the CONTRACTOR's personnel who is not performing his/her duties and responsibilities to PAGCOR's satisfaction. The CONTRACTOR shall not unilaterally pull out any of its personnel without the conformity of PAGCOR.
- xv. In the event that the CONTRACTOR fails to comply with any of its undertakings, as set forth in this Service Contract, PAGCOR shall be released from its obligations under this Service Contract, without prejudice to its rights of restitution, recovery and damages.
- xvi. This Service Contract, and all the rights and interests herein, may not be assigned or sub-contracted to another without the consent of the other party.
- xvii. In the event that facts and circumstances arise or are discovered which render this Contract disadvantageous to the Government, as determined by PAGCOR, the Parties hereto agree to immediately to renegotiate its terms and conditions, or at the option of PAGCOR, terminate the same.
- xviii. This Service Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter contained in it and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous contracts, representations, warranties and understandings of the parties. No supplement, variation or amendment to this Service Contract shall be binding unless executed in writing by all the parties thereto.

xix. Kind of Food Served (LOT 1):

- a. The Service Provider should be able to serve Asian, American and Mexican dishes.
- b. The Service Provider should be able to serve easy to prepare food and snacks.
- c. The Service Provider should cater mainly to Class B (High Limits) and Class C (Mass Market).

QUALIFICATIONS:

FOR CASINO GUESTS, PLAYERS AND CUSTOMERS FOR RONQUILLO SATELLITE (LOT 1)

1. The establishment should be located within Ronquillo Satellite but outside of PAGCOR leased areas. No rental shall be charged by PAGCOR.
2. The applicant must have at least three (3) years experience in the restaurant industry.

FOR CASINO GUESTS, PLAYERS AND CUSTOMERS FOR RONQUILLO SATELLITE (LOT 1) AND EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. The Service Provider shall exercise prompt delivery of service when order is placed.
2. The Service Provider's personnel shall observe the practice of "Clean As You Go" policy.

FOOD HANDLING:

FOR CASINO GUESTS, PLAYERS AND CUSTOMERS FOR RONQUILLO SATELLITE (LOT 1) AND EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. Usage of gloves by kitchen personnel must be observed at all times (gloves for dry/raw food must not be used to serve wet/cooked food).
2. Salads that are prepared in advance must be properly stored and transported in a cold temperature.
3. Heating of food must be available upon request of the customer.
4. If food will be cooked in a different location, the Service Provider must transport food that is tightly covered at least thirty (30) minutes before service.

MENU CYCLE:

FOR CASINO GUESTS, PLAYERS AND CUSTOMERS FOR RONQUILLO SATELLITE (LOT 1) AND EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. The menu should consist of varied selections from vegetables, fruits, pork, beef, chicken, fish and seafood.
2. A one (1) month advance menu must be submitted to the Food Committee for approval.
3. Dessert methods of cooking should be used everyday in the preparation of meals to provide choices. (Boiled + baked + steamed) or (fried + boiled + sautéed) or (grilled + boiled + baked).
4. Foods with compatible or varied flavors should be offered (e.g. adobo and sinigang; paksiw and fried; stew and grilled).

FOR EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. Vegetables should always be available.
2. Dessert should vary like fresh fruits, salads (e.g. fruit, buco, buco pandan) and sweets like leche flan and ube yam.
3. Two (2) or more foods with strong flavors should be avoided in the same meal.
4. Salty food choices should not be present in the same meal schedule.
5. Portion control in serving of viands must be observed and standardized.
6. Actual food served must be at least 85% compliant with the approved menu.
7. Fat portions in meat should be trimmed.
8. Processed food should be limited to not more than three (3) times a week.
9. The menu should be changed periodically upon mutual agreement with PAGCOR Management.
10. Color combination & food presentation must be observed.

ACTUAL FOOD DELIVERY:

FOR CASINO GUESTS, PLAYERS AND CUSTOMERS FOR RONQUILLO SATELLITE (LOT 1) AND EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. Food served must not appear too oily, dry or soaked in its own fat.

2. Hot food should be served hot at 140F, cold food should be served cold at least 40F.
3. Food arrangement should be attractive and garnished.

FOR EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. Variety of sizes and shapes of food items should be included in each menu.
2. Texture and consistency should be observed accordingly.

PROVISIONS OF HEALTHY MEALS:

FOR EMPLOYEE'S MEALS FOR RONQUILLO AND UNIVERSAL SATELLITE (LOT 2):

1. The Service Provider shall have interest and commitment to service pre-ordered healthy meals. Healthy meals are defined as: A healthy diet is complete with all essential nutrients needed to perform daily activities and is balanced in terms of carbohydrates, proteins, vitamins and mineral distribution. Healthy meals help support the goal of gradually changing to a healthy diet and healthy lifestyle.
2. The Service Provider shall agree to prepare the healthy meal according to the approved budget for employees.

II. F&B BUDGET and SCHEDULE OF PAYMENT

1. The total budget for this Service Contract shall be **Thirty-Eight Million Two Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Forty-Seven Pesos and 10/100 (PhP38,256,047.10)** for a period of one (1) year or **Seventy-Six Million Five Hundred Twelve Thousand Ninety-Four Pesos and 20/100 (PhP76,512,094.20)** for a period of two (2) years (the "Budget").

2. Payment shall be based on actual consumption and billing and shall be subject to the appropriate withholding taxes.

3. The Service Provider shall be responsible for the Payment of Utility Charges. All electricity and water bills and other charges necessary and incidental to the operation and other charges necessary and incidental to the operation of the Service Provider shall be for its account.

4. PAGCOR shall not be under any obligation to pay the CONTRACTOR the entire amount of the Budget. Moreover, the aggregate billings under this Contract shall not exceed the total budget.

5. The CONTRACTOR shall submit a VAT exclusive and zero rated billing statement to PAGCOR on a weekly basis together with all checks signed by the approving authority/authorized signatories of the Arcade. However, F&B items / billings found unsatisfactory and / or not conformed to by PAGCOR shall not be paid. PAGCOR shall pay the billing statement within thirty (30) calendar days from its receipt of the billing statement provided that any additional, necessary and / or required

supporting documents are submitted by the CONTRACTOR and are verified by PAGCOR.

6. PAGCOR shall not be liable for any other costs except as provided for under this Contract.

III. CONTRACT TERM

1. This Contract shall be effective from June 21, 2014 and shall terminate on June 20, 2016. However, this Contract shall be automatically terminated if the Budget is exhausted before the termination date.

2. PAGCOR may terminate this Contract with or without cause, without need for judicial intervention, and without incurring any obligation whatsoever, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the CONTRACTOR.

3. Should the CONTRACTOR incur delay in the performance of its obligations, the CONTRACTOR shall pay a penalty of one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) of the total cost of the Contract for each day of delay, including Sundays and Holidays, beyond the specific period. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of the Contract. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the Agreement, PAGCOR shall have the option to rescind the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

4. In case the CONTRACTOR still fails to deliver the Services after the lapse of thirty (30) days from the supposed date of implementation as provided for in this Contract, PAGCOR shall have the option to terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

IV. NO EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE OR AGENCY/PARTNERSHIP RELATIONSHIP

1. There shall be no employer-employee relationship between PAGCOR and the employees of the CONTRACTOR. The CONTRACTOR shall have the entire charge, control and supervision of the Services herein agreed upon. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of its agents, personnel and all persons allowed by it to have access to PAGCOR's premises, for any injury which may be caused to any person or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part of PAGCOR's premises. Any accident, injury or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any agent, personnel of the CONTRACTOR consequent to the performance of the Services under this Service Contract shall be the CONTRACTOR's sole responsibility. The CONTRACTOR further binds itself to indemnify and hold PAGCOR free and harmless from any claim on account of the aforementioned injuries or damages.

2. Any offense committed by any of the CONTRACTOR's personnel shall constitute a breach of this Service Contract. PAGCOR shall communicate to the CONTRACTOR all instances of such breach for immediate and appropriate action by the CONTRACTOR.

3. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all of obligations as an employer under the *Labor Code*, its implementing rules and regulations and all other applicable laws and regulations. Non-compliance therewith shall be for its exclusive risk and responsibility and shall constitute a violation of and a ground for the termination of this Service Contract.

4. The relationship between the parties shall be limited to the performance of the Services as stipulated under this Service Contract. Nothing herein shall be construed to create a general partnership between the parties, or to authorize any party to bind the other, except as set forth in this Service Contract, or to borrow money on behalf of another party, or to use the credit of any party for any purpose.

V. WARRANTIES, CLEARANCES, PERMITS, LICENSES and TAXES

1. The CONTRACTOR warrants that there are no actions, suits or proceedings pending or threatened, which may have a material adverse effect on its ability to fulfil its obligations under this Contract or on its operations, business, properties, assets or business condition.

2. All taxes, amounts, claims, and expenses pertaining to clearances, licenses, permits, registrations or renewals thereof, required by PAGCOR or the appropriate government entities for the Services to be performed under this Service Contract shall be for the exclusive account of CONTRACTOR.

3. The CONTRACTOR shall pay its taxes in full and on time. The CONTRACTOR shall also present a tax clearance from the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and a copy of its income and business tax returns, duly stamped, received and validated by the BIR, indicating the tax payments made thereon. Its failure to do so shall entitle PAGCOR to suspend payment for services rendered by the CONTRACTOR.

VI. INDEMNIFICATION

1. The CONTRACTOR will defend, protect, indemnify, and hold PAGCOR harmless from any and all adverse claims that may be made by any party in connection with this Service Contract. The indemnification is limited to the services delivered to PAGCOR by the CONTRACTOR and does not cover third party claims not authorized by the CONTRACTOR.

2. The CONTRACTOR hereby holds PAGCOR its guests, corporate affiliates, directors, officers, employees and agents free and harmless from any and all actions or liabilities arising out of this Service Contract, including, without being limited to, claims for unpaid and back wages, regularization, and other terms and conditions of employment, as well as civil and criminal liabilities that the CONTRACTOR and / or PAGCOR may incur as a result of, or arising out of, the conduct and / or pursuit of Services and to indemnify the PAGCOR from and against the costs of defending any action, suit or proceedings, including legal fees or other expenses incurred in relation to any such claims mentioned above.

3. The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and shall hold PAGCOR, its directors, officers, employees, agents, customers and guests and corporate affiliates and any employee or agent thereof (each of the foregoing, being hereinafter referred to individually as the "Indemnified Party") free and harmless against any and all liability to

third parties (other than liability solely the fault of the indemnified party) arising from the negligence of the CONTRACTOR or its agents including (but not limited to) the violation of any third party's trade secret, proprietary information, trademark, copyright or patent rights in connection with the use of PAGCOR of the CONTRACTOR's services.

4. The CONTRACTOR agrees to protect and to exercise due care and proper handling of the properties of PAGCOR during the performance of the Services. The CONTRACTOR shall be jointly and severally liable with its personnel and shall indemnify and hold PAGCOR free and harmless for any death, injury or damage to PAGCOR and to third person or loss, breakage, or destruction of properties, as a consequence of the CONTRACTOR's acts or omissions, wilful intent or negligence, during the performance of the Services or its obligations under this Service Contract.

5. The CONTRACTOR shall be liable in case of theft, robbery or any loss to PAGCOR's premises serviced by the CONTRACTOR's personnel. The CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to replace, repair or restitute any loss involving its personnel.

VII. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

To guarantee the faithful performance of the CONTRACTOR of all of its obligations under this Service Contract, PAGCOR shall deduct from its monthly payments to the CONTRACTOR an amount equal to five percent (5%) of its monthly payments. However, the total deductions shall not exceed the total amount of Three Million Eight Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Four Pesos and 71/100 (PhP3,825,604.71).

The Performance Security shall be retained by PAGCOR, without interest, during the pendency of this Service Contract and any extension thereof. The Performance Security shall not only be released after the termination of this Service Contract and/or the issuance by PAGCOR of the final Certificate of Acceptance and after deducting any and all claims that PAGCOR may have against the CONTRACTOR.

VIII. CLAIMS AND DISPUTES

All claims and disputes relating to or arising out of this Contract, shall as much as possible, be settled amicably by the parties before resorting to any judicial action.

If the parties fail to settle their difference or disputes, the parties waiving for the purpose any other venue, hereby agree that the courts of the City of Manila shall be the exclusive venue of any or all actions or suits between the parties to the exclusion of all other courts and venues. This exclusive venue provision shall apply even in cases for declaration of nullity of this Contract in its entirety or in part.


