ANNEX A

Attachment to Application Form Part I

CRITERIA/REQUIREMENTS FOR A PROPOSED POKER CLUB SITE

- 1. Not less than 200 m from schools and places of worship/churches
 - Schools referred to herein are educational institutions duly registered with the Department of Education (DepEd) and Commission on Higher Education (CHED).
 - Places of worship/churches referred to herein are stand-alone places of worship holding at least 1 day of regular worship or service in a week.
- 2. Not less than the radial distance requirement, as approved by the PAGCOR Board, from another PAGCOR-authorized gaming site, PAGCOR-operated or licensed casino, SM arcade or VIP club.
- 3. Not less that five (5) kilometers, measured via access road, from an existing Poker club.

Note: The distance restrictions/requirements as provided for under Item nos. 1, 2, and 3 above shall not apply to malls/arcades and three (3)-star hotels and resorts accredited by the Department of Tourism.

- 4. Measurement of distance in relation to items 1, 2, and 3 above
 - Distance from proposed gaming site to school, places of worship, another gaming site, PAGCOR-regulated or operated casino, SM arcade or VIP club, except for poker clubs, will be measured using radial or point to point straight distance from property line to property line. In measuring the radial distance, Google Maps' distance measurement tool must be used.
 - Distance from proposed gaming site to another poker club will be measured using access roads from proposed poker club site to reach the existing poker club using the shortest route. This will take into consideration one-way roads, U-turn slots, etc. In measuring distance using access roads, Google Maps' directions tool must be used considering the shortest route.
- 5. Poker club location (type of establishment/area) the following are the types of establishments and areas where a Poker club shall be located; no stand-alone gaming site will be allowed.
 - a. Within malls/arcades
 - These are commercial buildings where the majority of the located establishments provide retail sales, leisure, and entertainment to customers.
 - Poker Club must be within the mall's general premises. This may include non-connected annexes that have similar leisure and entertainment establishments as that of the mall (restaurants, etc). Typically, the annex area will belong to the same complex or share the same parking area of the mall.

b. General and Commercial Buildings:

- Address classified by LGU Zoning Body as a commercial building.
- Multi-door building where tenants provide commercial services (retail, distribution, services, banking, food, etc).
- Building should not be located beside or across informal settler dwellings.
- Building will allow signage on the outlet's façade.
- Mixed-use Commercial/Residential Condominium buildings are classified under this category. For these types of buildings, the proposed gaming site must be located in the commercial area (normally the lower floors).
- Building must either have a supplied generator or allow the gaming site to have its own generator.

c. Hotels / Resorts

Proposed Poker club must be located:

- inside the building or within the same complex/premises as the Hotel / Resort.
- in an identified commercial space of the hotel (as opposed to guest rooms).

Note: Stand-alone gaming site refers to a site located in a solitary building or establishment, and is not part of any commercial complex or compound.

- If there is an LGU resolution on specific guidelines on the establishment of a gaming site, such guidelines must be complied with. The Applicant's compliance with said guidelines does not dispense with its fulfillment of PAGCOR's requirements stated herein.
- 7. Poker Club area requirement must accommodate a minimum of four (4) Poker tables.
