**SUBJECT : AMENDMENTS TO THE GAMING SITE REGULATORY MANUALS
FOR ELECTRONIC AND BINGO GAMES ON EXTENSION OF
GAMING LICENSE VALIDITY PERIOD**

Please be advised that the PAGCOR Board of Directors approved in its meeting held on December 6, 2017 the amendments to the regulatory manuals for the following:

1. Redefinition of terms for pertinent types of fees;
2. New Application Fee and Renewal Fee amounts;
3. Revised procedures and guidelines for payment of applicable fees;
4. Revised procedures and guidelines for conduct of site inspection;
5. New set of conditions and guideline necessary for gaming site approval; and
6. Extended three (3)-year validity for both the Gaming License and renewal License.

Cut-off for the implementation of the revised 3-year validity period and the corresponding Application Fee and Renewal Fee shall be on applicants/operators with ongoing applications (new and renewal) who have not yet paid the Application Fee or Renewal Fee whichever is applicable. Notwithstanding, operators with valid gaming licenses may also avail of the 3-year license validity period subject to payment of the corresponding Renewal Fee.

The Operators shall be responsible for keeping updated the other requirements from other Government agencies (LONO, Mayor's Permit, etc.), and the expiration/absence of which during the extended validity period shall be ground for revocation of the License.

The aforementioned amendments shall be applicable to the Gaming Site Regulatory Manuals version 3.0 for Electronic Games and Bingo Games.
