SUBJECT : APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF GAMING LICENSE

Please be advised that the PAGCOR Board of Directors approved the following relative to application for renewal of Gaming License for the gaming sites operating Electronic, Bingo and/or Poker games:

1. Operators whose Gaming Licenses have long been expired must complete all renewal requirements within a non-extendible period of ninety (90) days from receipt of notice; otherwise, their application shall be deemed abandoned and PAGCOR shall be constrained to enforce closure of Operators' gaming site operations in accordance with PAGCOR's Gaming Site Regulatory Manuals.
2. Operators whose Gaming Licenses are due to expire in less than six (6) months must file their applications for renewal immediately and complete all renewal requirements within a non-extendible period of ninety (90) days after the expiration date of their Gaming Licenses.
3. As a standard policy hereon and after, Operators whose Gaming Licenses are due to expire in six (6) months and after must file their Letter of Intent to Renew within seven (7) days from receipt of PAGCOR's regular notice to file their applications for renewal. Such notice shall inform the Operators six (6) months before expiration to comply with all requirements; otherwise, non-compliance shall mean ipso facto expiration of the Gaming License.

In case the Operator requests for an extension, the Operator shall submit a duly accomplished **Request for Extension of Application for License Renewal Form (GS Form No. 3-B)** on or before expiration date with corresponding extension fee of fifty thousand pesos (PhP50,000.00). The extension period shall be a month after the expiration date. Any additional extension will mean additional fee and only up to a maximum of three (3) months. Non-compliance within the said periods will mean automatic revocation of the Gaming License.
