AND OPERATION OF GAMING SITES OFFERING ELECTRONIC GAMES  
AND ELECTRONIC BINGO GAMES**

As approved by the PAGCOR Board of Directors, please be advised that the US\$50,000.00 non-refundable application fee shall not apply to Applicants for the establishment and operation of gaming sites offering electronic games and electronic bingo games.

Further, effective May 3, 2017, the Application Fee for the Gaming License on electronic games and electronic bingo games gaming sites shall increase to Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP250,000.00) which shall be **in lieu of** the following applicable fees prescribed in the Gaming Site Regulatory Manuals (GSRM) for Electronic Games and Bingo Games (i.e. total of PhP130,000.00) for a new site application:

1. Application Fee	-	PhP5,000.00
2. Inspection Fee	-	PhP40,000.00
3. Processing Fee	-	PhP50,000.00
4. Monitoring Fee	-	PhP35,000.00
Total	-	PhP130,000.00

The new Application Fee is non-refundable and must be paid in full.

The new application fee of PhP250,000.00 shall not apply to current applicants who have already paid the aggregate amount of PhP95,000.00 for application, inspection and processing fees under the old scheme.

The above-mentioned GSRMs shall be amended accordingly to reflect the above changes in application fee.
